The course focused on the 6 C's. Critical thinking, communication, collaboration, creativity, character, and citizenship, and their integration with AI platforms designed for education. These six competencies are essential skills for students to develop in today's world, helping them solve problems, work with others, express ideas, innovate, build ethical values, and participate responsibly in society. The course introduced several AI tools such as perplexity, claude, magic school, eduaide, invideo and heygen, specifically created for classroom use, which are adaptable to all age groups, making them practical for diverse educational settings.

Personal feedback pertaining to the learning experience is that while the teacher presented valuable new AI tools, the first two days were heavily theoretical and not very interactive, which sometimes led to feeling overwhelmed by the amount of information and could have easily lost someone's interest. However, the teacher incorporated team-building activities to help participants engage physically and recap key concepts. The last day was more hands-on, allowing ample time to explore the AI tools, clarify doubts, and gain practical understanding. This balance between theory and practice enhanced the overall learning experience, making the course beneficial despite the initial information overload.
