As a newly appointed Deputy Head, I had the invaluable opportunity to participate in the Erasmus+ training on AI and Digital Leadership, held in Ghent, Belgium, from the 8th to the 10th of September, 2025. The experience was exceptionally positive and enriching.

Set in the city of Ghent, the training brought together ten participants from the local Church Schools sector. Eight of these, including myself, were members of senior leadership teams within the respective schools, while the remaining two represented the Secretariat for Catholic Education. Immediately evident was the shared eagerness to explore the transformative potential of artificial intelligence in education.

The sessions were clearly structured and expertly delivered, combining theoretical insights with hands-on practical activities. We examined the implications of AI for teaching, learning, and school management, and considered how digital leadership can effectively drive the ethical and meaningful integration of these technologies in schools.

What stood out most was the collaborative atmosphere. The discussions were dynamic and provided participants with the opportunity to share experiences, express co-develop ideas. We left the training not only with a deeper understanding of AI in the educational context, but also with a renewed sense of purpose and direction.

One of the most promising outcomes of this training is the planned collaboration on the development of a comprehensive AI Policy for Schools as a forward-thinking framework designed to guide the responsible and strategic implementation of AI in education across Europe.
