The training course in Ljubljana was a highly valuable professional learning experience that enhanced my understanding of digital access, inclusion, and practical strategies to support all learners. The course content was directly relevant to my role as an Inclusion Coordinator, focusing on how digital tools and simple classroom activities can promote engagement and inclusion.

A key strategy I gained was the use of 'Heygen' to create communication passports for children with autism. By combining a child's photo with a digital voice, these videos provide non-verbal students with a way to express themselves, share personal information, and be fully included in their classroom communities.



I also learnt how the 6Cs can be embedded into everyday activities. For example, the Human Knot encourages collaboration, "Two truths and a lie" fosters critical thinking, and lining up according to date of birth without speaking promotes both communication and empathy. This last activity is particularly impactful, as it helps children understand alternative ways of communicating and the challenges non-verbal students may face, encouraging inclusion and understanding among peers.

Overall, the course offered both practical tools and inspiring strategies that I intend to implement across the schools I support, ensuring that inclusion becomes a tangible part of daily classroom practice.
