Between the 8th and 10th of September, I had the privilege to participate in an Erasmus+ exchange in Ghent, Belgium. The course, ***AI and Digital Leadership in Education***, proved to be a highly positive and enriching learning experience that broadened my professional understanding and practical skills in this rapidly developing field.

Throughout the sessions, we explored a range of key issues, including the importance of adopting AI in education, the role and core responsibilities of AI leadership, and the ethical considerations associated with its use. We were also introduced to the history of AI, the mechanisms by which AI systems obtain information, and strategies for overcoming bias. Other elements of the course included guidance on prompt engineering and applications of AI in assessment. One of the most important aspects of this training was the fact that we were introduced to numerous AI tools and we had the opportunity to experiment hands-on with a number of them. Finally we also had the opportunity to collaborate on an exercise where we started to draft an AI policy for our schools.
